In a moving tribute, Chamber President & CEO, Debbie Manning, announced the Sheriff’s final Chamber ceremony before his retirement this year. It was followed by a standing ovation for the Sheriff. Manning also shared the deadline had just passed for filing for candidates for his replacement. The Chamber was pleased to share that Lt. Jeff Leikauf, also present that evening, will be running for the office unopposed, welcoming him as our next El Dorado County Sheriff.

The Chamber has 11 directors, with David Maestas terming out and acknowledged for his years of service to the Chamber. Kevin Barri, Region Bank President with Wells Fargo, shared sentiments with his time as Chairman of the Board, and wittingly introduced the new Chairman of the Board, Craig Badolian, owner of BI Design Center, E Life Cycles, and Founder of Krikor Holdings LLC.
