

BUSINESS CONFIDENCE SURVEY

Since the last business confidence survey in July 2017, overall optimism has remained steady with just minimal movement in the questions below. On a scale of 0 to 100, current optimism among local business leaders is rated at 65.9, a minor decrease of .9% from a year ago. A score of 50 is considered neutral with any score above that considered optimistic.

Most of the movement between surveys was a small shift from leaders expecting increases in each category to some now expecting sales, profit, employment, and business conditions to remain the same over the next 12 months.



- Decrease: 4%




PROFITS

How is profit expected to change in the next 12 months?




How is employment expected to change in the next 12 months?


